The works of María Isabel Uribe are constantly telling stories about love and felicity, while confronting us other conditions: fears of losing independence and returning to the rhythm of everyday life. In her works, one finds topics such as handling with unanswered love, or the question of how it keeps moving after a big love gone astray. María Isabel Uribe searches for real feelings in our unsentimental, fast-paced world.

The work currently presented in the ABA Art Contemporani gallery attracts the viewer with its' freshness and humour. Under the title, "*I am very Domestic*," the young artist deals with the beauty of ordinary objects from life. Experiencing being a housewife and the mother of a baby, she knows the daily errands and work or managing a never-closing store named "*Family and Household*." With a pinch of irony, she tries to give us an understanding of the odds and ends that surround us every day, those which, although we often ignore them, occupy a steady place in our lives.

Always trying to reach into our deepest insides, the creator uses the visual language of different materials and tastes. Her work, including sculpture, installation, painting, photography and collage, could be called a gamble of contrasts: smooth felt and sterile plastic, digital work with handmade touches.



María Isabel Uribe was born in Neiva-Huila, Columbia. After finishing her studies of Visual Arts, she changed her environment and moved to Palma de Mallorca where she studied at the University of the Balearic Islands, and she also continued her studies of photography and the arts.
